## AUCTIONEER LICENSE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

A completed application is required prior to scheduling your Texas auctioneer exam. If your application is approved, we will notify the exam provider (PSI) and they will send you a postcard with information about scheduling your exam. You must pay the exam fee directly to the exam provider (PSI).

1. **NAME** – Provide your legal name as it will appear on your license. (Last, First, Middle Name, Suffix) Examples of a suffix include Jr., Sr., and II. (Mr. is not a suffix.)
2. **DATE OF BIRTH** – Provide your birthdate.
3. **GENDER** – Select whether you are male or female.
4. **SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER** – Social Security number disclosure is required by Section 231.302(c)(1) of the Texas Family Code in order to obtain a license. Your social security number is subject to disclosure to an agency authorized to assist in the collection of child support payments. For more information regarding child support payments, contact the [Texas Attorney General](#).
5. **MAILING ADDRESS** – Provide your current mailing address. This is the address where we will send you mail. This address can be a post office box. Add the zip plus-4 to help the postal service deliver mail more efficiently and accurately.
6. **PERSONAL PHONE NUMBER** – Provide a phone number, including the area code, where we can reach you during the day. This may be your office phone number where we can leave a message.
7. **EMAIL ADDRESS** – Provide your email address only if you agree to the following statement. By providing my email address I authorize the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) to send licensing communications and required notices to me by electronic mail. I understand that I may revoke this authorization in writing and that I must update my email address, or I will not receive these notices. I understand that the email address I have provided in this application will remain confidential except as permitted or required by law.
8. **BUSINESS NAME(S)** – Provide the name(s) of the business that employs you as an auctioneer. Use additional pages if needed.
9. **BUSINESS LOCATION** – Provide the physical location of the business listed in item 9. Use additional pages if needed.
10. **BUSINESS PHONE NUMBER** – Provide the telephone number, including the area code, of the business listed.
11. **CRIMINAL HISTORY** – Indicate if you have ever been convicted of, or placed on deferred adjudication for, any misdemeanor or felony, other than a minor traffic violation. If YES, complete and attach a [Criminal History Questionnaire \(PDF\)](#) for each offense.  
If you are worried your criminal history could prevent you from getting this license, Texas allows you to have your criminal history evaluated before submitting your application and non-refundable fees. To request a criminal history evaluation, submit a [Criminal History Evaluation Letter \(PDF\)](#), a completed [Criminal History Questionnaire \(PDF\)](#) for each crime you were convicted of, or placed on deferred adjudication for, and pay a \$10.00 fee.
12. **DISCIPLINARY ACTION HISTORY** – Indicate if you have ever had an occupational license, certification, or registration suspended, revoked, or denied in any state. If you have, complete and attach a [Disciplinary Action Questionnaire \(PDF\)](#) for each disciplinary action.
13. **INDIVIDUALLY ISSUED SALES TAX PERMIT NUMBER** – Provide your Texas sales tax permit number issued by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts. If you are exempt from paying Texas sales tax, you are required to submit a letter of exemption issued by the Texas Comptroller's office. To request an individual exemption letter, provide a letter to the Comptroller's office and provide the following information:
  - a. Your name, address, and telephone number
  - b. The type of auctioneering you will be doing

- If you are acting as an employee of a specific company, include the name and Texas Sales and Use Taxpayer Number of Employer
- If you are not responsible for collecting and remitting of Texas Sales and Use Tax on items auctioned, include the individual or company name and their Texas Sales and Use Tax Permit Number.
- Indicate how the Auctioneer Waiver letter from the Comptroller's office should be delivered to you, if your request is approved. i.e., mail, fax, email (you must indicate fax number and/or email address).

If your request is approved, a copy of the auctioneer letter is automatically sent to TDLR and to you. You can also contact the [Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts](#).

14. CITIZENSHIP – Select YES or NO to indicate if you are a citizen of the United States or a legal alien.
15. EDUCATION – Select YES or NO to indicate if you have a high school diploma or high school equivalency certificate.
16. EXAMINATION ONLY – If you want to get a Texas auctioneer license by taking the auctioneer exam, attach proof of the successful completion of 80 hours of classroom instruction at an auctioneer school with Department approved curriculum. A list of approved auctioneer schools can be found on the [TDLR website](#).
17. EMPLOYMENT ONLY – If you want to get a Texas auctioneer license by having held an Associate Auctioneer license for a minimum of two years, attach the Auctioneer Supervision record and successful completion of 80 hours of classroom instruction at an auctioneer school with the Department approved curriculum. A list of approved auctioneer schools can be found on the TDLR website.
18. RECIPROCITY – Select YES or NO to indicate if you are not a Texas resident and you are applying for a Texas auctioneer license through reciprocity. If you answered YES, complete item 22.
19. OUT-OF-STATE AUCTIONEER LICENSE – If you answered NO to item 19, list the state(s) and auctioneer license number of each state you are licensed as an auctioneer. Additionally, attach the following to your application: a copy of your current auctioneer license, a letter of certification from your state licensing authority confirming your license is valid and in good standing, and sign and date Item 21 Irrevocable Consent to Service of Process.
20. IRREVOCABLE CONSENT TO SERVICE OF PROCESS – If you answered NO to item 19, carefully read this statement before dating and signing this section.
21. STATEMENT OF APPLICANT – Carefully read the statement before signing and dating your application.
