LICENSE BY EXAMINATION APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED WITH YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE RETURNED. KEEP A COPY OF YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION, ALL ATTACHMENTS, AND YOUR CASHIER'S CHECK OR MONEY ORDER.

- 1. <u>NAME</u> Your name <u>must</u> match your government identification or driver license.
- 2. <u>DO YOU HAVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER</u> Disclosure is required by the <u>Texas Family Code</u> to obtain a license. Your Social Security Number is subject to disclosure to an agency authorized to assist in the collection of child support payments. For more information regarding child support payments, contact the <u>Texas Attorney General</u>.
- 3. DATE OF BIRTH MM/DD/YYYY
- 4. GENDER Select whether you are male or female.
- 5. PHONE NUMBER Provide a phone number where we can reach you during the day.
- 6. <u>EMAIL ADDRESS</u> By providing your email address you agree to receive communications and required notices by email and to keep a valid email address on file.
- 7. MAILING ADDRESS Provide the address where you receive mail. This address can be a post office box. Always keep your mailing address current with the Texas Department of License and Regulation, (TDLR).
- 8. TYPE OF LICENSE APPLYING FOR Select ONE. **See #11 below if education was earned in another state/country.
- 9. <u>CRIMINAL HISTORY</u> This <u>does not</u> include minor traffic violations. If **YES**, complete and attach a <u>Criminal History</u> <u>Questionnaire (PDF)</u>. If you are worried your criminal history could prevent you from getting this license, Texas allows you to have your criminal history evaluated <u>before</u> submitting this application and non-refundable fees. To request a criminal history evaluation, <u>do not continue</u> with this application. Download, complete and submit a <u>Criminal History Evaluation</u> <u>Letter</u>, a completed <u>Criminal History Questionnaire (PDF)</u> for each crime you were convicted of, or placed on deferred adjudication for, and pay a \$10.00 fee.
- 10. <u>DISCIPLINARY ACTION HISTORY</u> Indicate if you have ever had a professional license, certification, or registration suspended, revoked, or denied in any state. If you have, complete and attach a *Disciplinary Action Questionnaire (PDF)*.
- 11. OUT OF STATE/COUNTRY APPLICANTS This option is for applicants who do not qualify to transfer an out of state/out of country license and those individuals with training hours earned at an out of state school. Check our <u>TDLR</u> <u>website</u> for eligibility to transfer a license by substantial equivalence. **NOTE: Texas does not accept training by apprenticeship, except for a <u>Cosmetology Operator & a Class A Barber</u>.**

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR OUT OF STATE & OUT OF COUNTRY APPLICANTS

- Transcripts from another country must be evaluated by a Foreign Transcript Evaluation Provider registered with the <u>National Association of Credential Evaluation Services</u> or the <u>Association of</u> <u>International Credential Evaluators, Inc.</u> and mailed with this application. Instructions for obtaining a Foreign Credential Evaluation may be reviewed on our <u>website</u>.
