BOILER INSPECTOR COMMISSION APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The application must be completed and signed by the applicant. An application is not considered complete and will not be processed until all required items have been submitted. Attachments must be submitted on separate pieces of single-sided, 8½" x 11" paper.

DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED WITH YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE RETURNED. KEEP A COPY OF YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION, ALL ATTACHMENTS, AND YOUR CHECK OR MONEY ORDER.

- 1. NAME Provide your legal name as it will appear on your license. (Last, First, Middle Name, Suffix) Examples of a suffix include Jr., Sr., and III. (Mr. is not a suffix.)
- 2. DATE OF BIRTH Provide your birthdate.
- 3. GENDER Select whether you are male or female.
- 4. <u>SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER</u> Social Security number disclosure is required by Section 231.302(1) of the Texas Family Code in order to obtain a license. Your social security number is subject to disclosure to an agency authorized to assist in the collection of child support payments. For more information regarding child support payments, contact the *Texas Attorney General* or call (512) 460-6000 or (800) 252-8014.
- 5. <u>MAILING ADDRESS</u> Provide your current mailing address. This is the address where we will send you mail. This address can be a post office box. You can add the zip plus-4 to help the postal service deliver mail more efficiently and accurately.
- 6. <u>PHONE NUMBER</u> Provide a phone number, including the area code, where we can reach you during the day. This may be your office phone number where we can leave a message.
- 7. <u>EMAIL ADDRESS</u> Provide the email address. Please provide an email address that can receive license information and required notices from the department. The email address provided is subject to public disclosure and will be available on the TDLR website.
- CRIMINAL HISTORY Indicate if you have ever been convicted of, or placed on deferred adjudication for, any
 misdemeanor or felony, other than a minor traffic violation. If YES, complete and attach a <u>Criminal History</u>
 Questionnaire (PDF) for each offense.
 - If you are worried your criminal history could prevent you from getting this license, Texas allows you to have your criminal history evaluated before submitting your application and non-refundable fees. To request a criminal history evaluation, submit a *Criminal History Evaluation Letter*, a completed *Criminal History Questionnaire (PDF)* for each crime you were convicted of, or placed on deferred adjudication for, and pay a \$25 fee.
- DISCIPLINARY ACTION HISTORY Indicate if you have ever had an occupational license, certification, or registration suspended, revoked, or denied in any state. If you have, complete and attach a <u>Disciplinary Action Questionnaire</u> (PDF) for each disciplinary action.
- 10. <u>HAVE YOU EVER PASSED A JURISDICTION EXAMINATION TO BECOME A BOILER INSPECTOR</u> Indicate if you have taken and passed a written boiler inspector examination from another jurisdiction. If YES, provide the name of the jurisdiction administering the exam and the date of the exam.
- 11. HAVE YOU EVER BEEN ISSUED A BOILER INSPECTOR COMMISSION OR CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY Indicate if you have been issued an inspector commission or certificate of competency. If YES, provide the commission or certificate number, original date of issue, expiration date and the name of the issuing jurisdiction. Note: After proper investigation, the executive director may accept an inspection commission issued to a person by any other jurisdiction that has a written examination equal to that of Texas.
- 12. STATEMENT OF APPLICANT Carefully read the statement of applicant before you sign and date your application.
- 13. EMPLOYER'S STATEMENT This section must be completed by your authorized inspection agency employer.
