JOURNEYMAN INDUSTRIAL ELECTRICIAN LICENSE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED WITH YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE RETURNED. KEEP A COPY OF YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION, ALL ATTACHMENTS, AND YOUR CHECK OR MONEY ORDER.

1. **NAME** – Provide your legal name in the spaces provided. (Last, First, Middle Name, Suffix) Examples of a suffix include Jr., Sr., and III. (Mr. is not a suffix.)
2. **GENDER** – Select whether you are male or female.
3. **DATE OF BIRTH** – Provide your birthdate.
4. **SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER** – Social Security number disclosure is required by Section 231.302(1) of the Texas Family Code in order to obtain a license. Your social security number is subject to disclosure to an agency authorized to assist in the collection of child support payments. For more information regarding child support payments, contact the [Texas Attorney General](#) or call (512) 460-6000 or (800) 252-8014.
If you do not have a social security number, complete the [Social Security Number Status Certification](#) form. See additional information at [Verification of Lawful Presence](#).
5. **MAILING ADDRESS** – Provide your current mailing address. This is the address where we will send you mail. This address can be a post office box. Add the zip plus-4 to help the postal service deliver mail more efficiently and accurately.
6. **PHYSICAL ADDRESS** – Provide your physical address of your residence. Do not use a post office box for this address.
7. **EMAIL ADDRESS** – By providing my email address I authorize the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) to send licensing communications and required notices to me by electronic mail. I understand that I may revoke this authorization in writing and that I must update my email address, or I will not receive these notices. I understand that the email address I have provided in this application will remain confidential except as permitted or required by law.
8. **PHONE NUMBER** – Provide a telephone number, including the area code, where we can reach you during the day. This may be your office phone number where we can leave a message.
9. **CRIMINAL HISTORY** – Indicate if you have ever been convicted of, or placed on deferred adjudication for, any Misdemeanor or Felony, other than a minor traffic violation. If YES, complete and attach a [Criminal History Questionnaire \(PDF\)](#) for each offense.
If you are worried your criminal history could prevent you from getting this license, Texas allows you to have your criminal history evaluated before you submit your application and pay non-refundable fees. To request a criminal history evaluation, submit a [Criminal History Evaluation Letter \(PDF\)](#), a completed [Criminal History Questionnaire \(PDF\)](#) for each crime you were convicted of, or placed on deferred adjudication for, and a \$10.00 fee.
10. **DISCIPLINARY ACTION HISTORY** – Indicate if you have ever had a professional license, certification, or registration suspended, revoked, or denied in any state. If Yes, complete and attach a [Disciplinary Action Questionnaire \(PDF\)](#) for each disciplinary action.
11. **LICENSING REQUIREMENTS** – You must have at least 8,000 hours of on-the-job training as a licensed electrical apprentice under the supervision of a master electrician prior to taking the exam. When your experience has been approved, PSI will mail you a postcard with information on how to schedule your exam. ***Effective January 1, 2023, TDLR will no longer accept the NCCER Industrial Electrician Written Assessment. Applicants who apply for a journeyman industrial electrician license on or after January 1, 2023, will be required to take and pass the Texas Journeyman Industrial Electrician examination administered by PSI.*** An Experience Verification Form is required for each employer and must be signed by the supervising master electrician.
12. **STATEMENT OF APPLICANT** – Carefully read the statement before signing and dating your application.
13. **EXPERIENCE VERIFICATION FORM** – An Experience Verification Form or letter on company letterhead must be completed and signed by the supervising master electrician. Make additional copies of the Experience Verification for as needed. All areas of this document must be completed.

11. LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for a Journeyman Industrial Electrician License, you must:

- Pass the Texas Journeyman Industrial Electrician Exam. **Effective January 1, 2023, TDLR will no longer accept the NCCER Industrial Electrician Written Assessment. Applicants who apply for a journeyman industrial electrician license on or after January 1, 2023, will be required to take and pass the Texas Journeyman Industrial Electrician examination administered by PSI.**
- Complete at least 8,000 hours of on-the-job training as a licensed electrical apprentice under the supervision of a master electrician. An Experience Verification Form is required for each employer and must be signed by the supervising master electrician.
