



Online Device Renewal: Step-By-Step Directions

Before you get started:

- Please note that if the credit card limit is less than the amount on the invoice, the payment will not be accepted.
- Payments will take 24-48 hours to appear online in your account.
- **Please make sure to add noreply@tdlr.texas.gov to your address book so that you'll receive your registration confirmation email.**







Click on the link to verify email account. You will be directed back to the Fuel Metering and Quality Device portal.



Log in using the email and password created at registration.




This page is to associate a client to your online user account. Enter in the client ID and click View Client Information. Your client ID can be found on your invoice or license.


