MOTORCYCLE INSTRUCTOR LICENSE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED WITH YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE RETURNED. KEEP A COPY OF YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION, ALL ATTACHMENTS, AND YOUR CHECK OR MONEY ORDER.

- 1. NAME Provide your legal name in the spaces provided. (Last, First, Middle Name, Suffix) Examples of a suffix include Jr., Sr., and II. (Mr. is not a suffix.)
- 2. DATE OF BIRTH Provide your birth date.
- 3. GENDER Select whether you are male or female.
- 4. <u>SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER</u> Social Security Number disclosure is required by Section 231.302(c)(1) of the Texas Family Code to obtain a license. Your social security number is subject to disclosure to an agency authorized to assist in the collection of child support payments. For more information regarding child support payments, contact the <u>Texas Attorney General</u>.
- 5. <u>MAILING ADDRESS</u> Provide your current mailing address. This is the address where we will send you mail. This address can be a post office box. You can add the zip plus-4 to help the postal service deliver mail more efficiently and accurately.
- 6. <u>PHONE NUMBER</u> Provide a telephone number, including the area code, where we can reach you during the day. This may be your office phone number where we can leave a message.
- 7. <u>EMAIL ADDRESS</u> Provide your email address. By providing my email address I authorize TDLR to send licensing communications and required notices to me by electronic mail. I understand that I may revoke this authorization in writing and that I must update my email address, or I will not receive these notices. I understand that the email address I have provided in this application will remain confidential except as permitted or required by law.
- 8. <u>DRIVER LICENSE NUMBER</u> Provide the number on your driver license, the listed state on the license, the class, and date the license was issued and will expire. If your driving record does not meet the requirements of 116 T.A.C. §98.21(4) and (5), then your application will be denied. <u>Submit a clear photocopy of your current, valid driver license.</u>
- 9. EDUCATION Select whether you have a High School Diploma or GED.
- 10. <u>INSTRUCTOR TRAINING COURSE</u> Select whether you have completed an instructor training course administered by an approved instructor training provider. <u>Submit a copy of the certificate of completion of your Instructor Training Course. You must also submit proof of certification for each motorcycle type course you are approved to teach.</u>
- 11. <u>FOR OUT OF STATE APPLICANTS</u> Select Yes or No, if you have held a motorcycle license issued by another state(s) or jurisdiction.
 - If <u>YES</u>, a document on official letterhead issued by the state or other jurisdiction will need to be submitted. The letter must state the license has been active and in good standing continuously for the previous year and the applicant has taught both the classroom and range portions of the course at least six times.
 - If <u>NO</u>, a document on official letterhead issued by the administrator of the course will need to be submitted. The letter must state the applicant's authorization to teach the course has been active and in good standing continuously for the previous year and the applicant has taught both the classroom and range portions of the course at least six times.

- 13. <u>CRIMINAL HISTORY</u> Indicate if you have ever been convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication for any Misdemeanor or Felony, other than a minor traffic violation. If YES, complete and attach a <u>Criminal History</u> <u>Questionnaire (PDF)</u> for each offense.
 - If you are worried your criminal history could prevent you from getting this license, Texas allows you to have your criminal history evaluated before submitting your application and non-refundable fees. To request a criminal history evaluation, submit a <u>Criminal History Evaluation Letter (PDF)</u>, a completed <u>Criminal History Questionnaire (PDF)</u> form for each crime you were convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication for and a \$10.00 fee.
 - **REQUIRED FOR ALL NEW APPLICANTS -** Fingerprinting: All new applicants must submit fingerprints for a national criminal history record review. The applicant is responsible for paying the fee associated with this review to the fingerprint service vendor used by Texas Department of Public Safety. Once your completed application is received by TDLR, instructions on how to schedule an appointment to be fingerprinted will be emailed to you. Be sure your email address is current and legible to receive the fingerprinting information. To be eligible for licensing, you must successfully pass a criminal history background check.
- 14. <u>DISCIPLINARY ACTION HISTORY</u> Indicate if you have ever had a professional license, certification, or registration suspended, canceled, revoked, or denied in any state. If yes, complete and attach a <u>Disciplinary Action</u> <u>Questionnaire (PDF)</u> for each disciplinary action.
- 15. STATEMENT OF APPLICANT Carefully read the statement of applicant before signing and dating your application.
